# How to apply to EMU

EMU uses a rolling admissions process. We will begin to process your application as soon as it is received.

Eastern uses the following criteria for freshman admission:

- GPA from high school or previous college
- ACT/SAT test scores
- high school curriculum
- academic and personal honors

You may apply using the paper application included here or you can apply online at: [www.emich.edu/admissions/apply](http://www.emich.edu/admissions/apply).

You should include the following documents with your application to EMU:

- completed application and \$30 (\$20 on-line) processing fee
- official transcripts from all high schools\* and colleges attended, in sealed envelopes
- official scores sent directly from ACT and/or SAT\*

\*High school transcripts and ACT/SAT scores are not required for students applying as transfers with 12 or more college-level transferrable credits.

## Information for transfer students

Transferring your credits is easy at Eastern.

Transfer services include:

- transfer equivalency information
- unofficial tabulation of credit
- articulation agreements with other colleges and universities
- available programs of study
- courses needed to satisfy general education and major/minor requirements
- applicability of transfer work to general education requirements
- applicability of transfer work to specific programs
- general admission policies and procedures

EMU is part of the MACRAO agreement among Michigan community colleges and four-year universities.
